

## Mock cable edge shrug – Lambswool 2 ply

Size	34	36	38	40	42	44	46	48
Dress size	12	14	16	18	20	22	24	26

Knit in 2ply **Lambswool** at T3 this makes a loose fitting garment. I used less than 120g for size 14.

**Tension** is 36 sts and 56 rows over 10cm/ 4 inches.

### Instructions:


1. Knit all pieces using diagrams on following pages
2. Stitch together, then finish off front edge, bottom and sleeves with the following edge, wrong side facing:

### MOCK CABLE edge


Pick up 3 sts with a 3 prong tool and hang them on 3 ndls. K 8 rws using your hand as weight. Pick up the next 3 sts [allow about a 3 st gap between – i.e don't make the edge loose] and hang them on top of the first sts. Repeat until you are completely around the piece. To finish, K 8 rws of the last pick up and rehang on the first 3 st group. Cast off.




